In-service Civil Servants applying for the post of Assistant Auditor General (AAG) must meet the following criteria:

- a. Minimum qualification of Bachelor's degree;
- b. Completed a minimum of 2 years of active service in the current position level (i.e. at P2) at the time of the announced application deadline:
- c. Should be in the same super-structure group:
- d. Should have served a minimum duration equal to the long term training period in the same position at the time of the announced application deadline if he/she has availed a long term training;
- e. Clean service record; and
- f. Performance rating of 'Good' and above for the last two years.

Eligible in-service Civil Servants may apply with the following documents. Applicants with relevant qualification/training, and work experience shall be given preference for the purpose of shortlisting.

- 1. Application;
- 2. Curriculum Vitae;
- 3. Performance Ratings for the last 2 years (Moderated rating for non-Schedule A agency);
- 4. Valid CID copy;
- 5. Valid Audit Clearance;
- 6. Valid Security Clearance;
- 7. Copies of academic transcripts;
- 8. Copies of relevant training certificates; and
- No Objection Certificate endorsed by HRC.

In-service Civil Servants applying for the post of Research Officer must have completed a minimum of three (3) years of active service at the time of the announced application deadline.
