**OFFICE ORDER**

**Subject: Additional precautionary measures to contain spread of COVID 19**

While the Government has lifted the lockdown with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> February 2022, the battle against COVID 19 pandemic is not yet over. We continue to remain expose to high risk of contacting and spreading virus at any time.

In order to ensure safety of ourselves, families and community, the Management has decided to adopt additional precautionary measures as below:

- Those works which can be done from HOME should be encouraged to carry out;
- No external visitors should be entertained in office, unless absolutely necessary;
- Refrain from conducting field visits to southern border Dzongkhags/places;
- Officials returning from Red Zone should HOME QUARANTINE for additional ONE week;
- Officials who have recovered from the virus should observe additional 14 days HOME QUARANTINE calculated from the date of declaration of negative result;
- Individuals should visit flu clinic for any symptoms such as sore throat, cough etc.; and
- Data packages will be facilitated, wherever necessary.

The above measures shall remain in force until further notice.
