In-service Civil Servants applying for the post of Assistant Auditor General (AAG) must meet the following criteria:

- a. Minimum qualification of Bachelor's degree;
- b. Completed a minimum of 2 years of active service in the current position level i.e at P2 at the time of the announced application deadline;
- c. Should be in the same super-structure group;
- d. Should have served a minimum duration equal to the long-term training period in the same position at the time of announced application deadline if he/she has availed a long term training;
- e. Clean service record; and
- f. Moderation Exercise Result/PE Rating of Good and above for the last two years.

Eligible in-service Civil Servants may apply with the following documents. Applicants with relevant qualification/training and work experience shall be given preference for the purpose of shortlisting.

- 1. Application
- 2. Curriculum vitae from the ZESt
- 3. Performance ratings for the last two consecutive years
- 4. Valid CID copy
- 5. Valid audit clearance
- 6. Valid security clearance
- 7. Copies of academic transcripts
- 8. Copies of relevant training certificates; and
- 9. No Objection Certificate endorsed by HRC
