Interested **In-Service** Civil Servants applying for the post must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Minimum qualification of Bachelor's degree;
- Completed a minimum of 2 years of active service in the current position level (i.e. at P2) at the time of the announced application deadline;
- Should be in the same super-structure group;
- Should have served a minimum duration equal to the long term training period in the same position at the time of the announced application deadline if he/she has availed a long term training;
- Clean service record; and
- Performance rating of 'Good' and above for the last two years.

The application along with the following documents must reach the Human Resource & International Relations Division (HRIRD) latest by **3rd May 2022**.

- Curriculum Vitae (ZEST generated)
- Performance Ratings for the last 2 years (*Moderated rating for non-Schedule A agency*);

- No Objection Certificate endorsed by HRC (if the applicant is from outside RAA)
