In-service Civil Servants applying for the post of Assistant Auditor General (AAG) must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum qualification of Bachelor's degree;
- Completed a minimum of 2 years of active service in the current position level i.e at P2 at the time of the announced application deadline;
- Should be in the same super-structure group;
- Should have served a minimum duration equal to the long-term training period in the same position at the time of announced application deadline if he/she has availed a long-term training;
- Clean service record; and
- Moderation Exercise Result/PE Rating of Very Good (both in Performance and Potential Assessment) on either of two for the last two years.
- Certification of completion of Level 1 & 2 e-learning course on Ethics and Integrity.
- The applicants must have a valid Leadership Potential & Situational judgement test results administered by the RCSC.
- The applicants must have a valid Leadership Development Program Certificate conducted by RCSC & RIM.

Eligible in-service Civil Servants may apply with the following documents. Applicants with relevant qualification/training and work experience shall be given preference for the purpose of shortlisting.

- Performance ratings for the last two consecutive years
- Valid CID copy
- Valid audit clearance
